

# Electric Charges - Residential

**How to calculate/estimate the electric charge on your bill:**

1. Read your electric meter. Subtract the previous bill's reading from the reading shown on your meter. Your last billing statement shows the "Reading Date" and the "Reading," so you know when to read and what to subtract. You can also estimate what your bill might be based on current usage.	 <hr/> KwH
2. Enter the Minimum Residential Customer Charge.	\$16.00
3. Multiply the Total Retail Rate by the kilowatt hours used.	<hr/> \$
6. Add the amounts from lines 2 and 3. This is the estimated electric portion of your utility bill.	<hr/> \$
