What is TVA Env/FCA Chg? It is the combination of the following:

**TVA Environmental Charge**

The rate TVA charges to cover environmental costs such as:  
 providing flood control, navigation and land management, economic development

**TVA Fuel Cost Adjustment:**

This rate fluctuates by pennies each month based on cost of fuel used to run  
 TVA power plants. The adjustment is driven by power demands. The higher the demand,  
 the higher the cost of fuel for providing that demand.

Winchester Utilities is a non-profit company that provides electricity purchased from TVA. Any additional revenue collected by the utility is used to maintain and upgrade the infrastructure.
